<p>PATRON USE/CHARGE OUT OF DEVICES, VIDEO GAMES, GAMING SYSTEM</p> <p>A library patron using/charging out devices, video games, gaming system must have, and be able to present, a current Norwich library card in good standing. Library patron must be a resident of the Norwich City School District. Library patrons who hold a Norwich library card but do not live in the Norwich City School District, cannot charge out or use devices and video games or sign up for the gaming system [e.g. Oxford, Sherburne, New Berlin residents etc.]. So, changing a library card from another library to Norwich, or just getting a Norwich library card, will not help them to access the above items. Address and residency in the school district appear on all patron records {"Norwich" for resident of school district; "NResident" for non-resident}.</p> <p>Library patrons who reside in other cities or townships in the Four County Library System should get cards in their local area, reason being that it helps with funding etc. for that local library. However, if a patron still wants a Norwich library card, for various reasons [e.g. work in Norwich, wants Norwich to be his/her main library etc.] he/she can get one at Norwich. The above restriction as to residency still applies for devices, video games, and the gaming system.</p>
