Substance Abuse Policy

It is the policy of Guernsey Memorial Library to maintain a drug free/alcohol free environment. Alcohol or illegal drugs on library property will not be tolerated. Any individual possessing, bringing onto the property, or partaking of alcohol, or illegal drugs on the property shall be subject to immediate removal from library property. Individuals are encouraged to use and store prescription drugs at home and are discouraged from bringing them onto the property as they might be subject to theft or otherwise be disruptive. If an individual appears to be impaired or otherwise under the influence of legal or illegal drugs or alcohol, it is at the Director's or the Director's designee's discretion to remove the individual from library property. Multiple infractions may result in the individual from being barred from the property for a period of time. The Board of Trustees can provide a suspended individual with a review of their case if they choose to dispute it.
