POLICY FOR GUERNSEY PARK

- 1. The Board of Trustees is happy to add the Guernsey Park to the recreation facilities available to the citizens of the community.
- 2. The Park is available for all to enjoy. A play area is available for small children only.
- 3. Maintenance of the Park is the responsibility of the Board of Trustees of Guernsey Memorial Library.
- 4. Any group reserving the Park for a public meeting must provide proof of liability insurance.
- 5. Because of availability of athletic fields and the limited amount of space in this park, no games are allowed.
- 6. Those using the Park are asked to keep it neat and clean and to refrain from walking in flower beds or other plantings.
- 7. Any group desiring to reserve the park or patio should fill out a Meeting Room Application and turn it in at the circulation desk. This application will outline any applicable fees.
- 8. No group may charge an admission fee to any event in the Park.
- 9. The Park must be left clean after use by a group. Damage caused by an organization's use will be charged to that organization.
- 10. The Park is a dawn to dusk park. Individuals found in the park or on library grounds when it and the library are closed may be asked to leave and may be prosecuted if they refuse to do so.
