Food & Drink

Food and drink are strictly prohibited at the library's computer workstations or near any library electronic equipment, and also in the stacks areas, excepting in cases where the library user has a documented medical condition requiring immediate access to food and drink. Food and drink are allowed at library tables and seating not associated with stacks or electronic equipment, and also in the library meeting room, staff areas, and the kitchen at the discretion of library staff. Food and drink are prohibited in Local History except where a documented need is presented to the Local History Room staff.

Eating and drinking should not disturb other library patrons. Items which frequently cause severe allergic reactions, such as nuts, should be avoided.

If your food or drink makes a mess, please be considerate and clean up after yourself. If you damage library furnishings, equipment, materials, or property while eating or drinking, you are financially responsible for the repair or replacement of the damaged items and may be banned from the library and its grounds.
