Odor Policy		
Guernsey Memorial Library is committed to access for all. As humans, our staff and patrons bring a wide array of odors into our space. We recognize that odor tolerance and sensitivity vary among individuals. If you object to the odor in any particular location in the library, we ask that you please relocate to an area that is more tolerable for you. If you notice any odor or other factor that could be indicative of a health hazard, please immediately alert staff so it can be addressed per our policies since any activity or substance posing a health hazard to patrons and employees is prohibited. Examples of odors that might constitute a possible health risk might include hazardous chemicals, fecal matter, bodily fluids, rotting food, smoke, communicable infection, or any substance that can damage the library or pose a risk to those in it. Upon notification of an odor that might pose a possible health hazard, staff will assess whether a risk is likely to be present, and will take steps to mitigate the situation as quickly as possible.
