<p>Excess personal property inside the library or on library grounds can be problematic for many reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>It clutters the building and property aesthetically.</li><li>It makes it difficult to access the library and park.</li><li>It can cause safety and egress problems.</li><li>It can promote theft and other crimes.</li></ul> <p>For these reasons, the library reserves the right to limit the property that individuals can bring into the park or the building.</p> <p>Excess property including large backpacks, sleeping bags, tents, and luggage may not be brought into the building.</p> <p>Wheeled conveyances that are not necessary for purposes of ambulation, including strollers, baby carriages, wagons, wheelchairs, scooters, luggage, bicycles, etc., are not allowed in the building.</p> <p>The library provides a limited number of lockers in the entry way and racks outside the building and locks for day use. A patron may request to use these at the service desk, subject to availability. If an item is left locked to a rack or in a locker at closing time, the library will unlock the items and place them in the dumpster.</p>
